- 1. Argument for casting the net broadly: function of representation of PAST work and FUTURE projections, necessarily eccentric and individualistic. Therefore, no need to arrive at consensus except over issues of inclusion.
- 2. Problems facing Lacanian Architecture educators and scholars. Lack of competent reviewers; even within the iPSA group, a variety of approaches that limit reviewers' competencies. Review problem might be fixed with more Lacanians conversant with architecture (unlikely); or by non-tenure-related development.
- 3. Getting Todd McGowan to ask Joan Copjec, and other ploys. Who should be included and how? Reprints (in Joan's case)? Jane Rendell (does she actually write about Lacan?).
- 4. Any non-architects writing on their view of what architecture means to Lacanian psychoanalysis? Could be TWO CFPs, one for us (assured), one for more speculative works.
- 5. Time table: 3 mos. for proposals; circulate them; return revised drafts by July 15.
- 6. Confer with Derek/Calum, July 15—30. They represent the publisher and the series.
- 7. Writing development: July 15—October 15?
- 8. EDITORS ... WHO AND FOR WHAT CREDIT? This may be beneficial for those undergoing P&T reviews.
- 9. Hiring a professional for copy editing? I know a good one but don't know her availability or terms.
- 10. Exchanging manuscripts would be good to stimulate our ideas generally; the aim is not to coerce any conformity but to see what others are doing.
